

Volunteering for Limmud Scotland

We are seeking a large number of volunteers to help with this event, both in the preparation and on the day itself. Everyone interested in learning about or celebrating Judaism, regardless of their religious affiliation, is welcome and encouraged to volunteer.

We are particularly looking for people with the following skills/resources:

- Madrichim to help with the children's activities (PVGs can be arranged through SCoJeC)
- People with First Aid qualifications
- Car drivers to help collect various items in the week before the event
- Offers of home hospitality for presenters or other visitors to Edinburgh
- Technical skills to help with audio-visual equipment
- Photography skills

On the day itself, we will need around 50 volunteers to help with a range of activities, including:

- Setting up room layouts from 8 to 9.30 am
- Putting up venue plans, directions and other instructions for participants
- Registering presenters, stallholders and participants from 9.00 am
- Responding to participant, stallholder and presenter queries
- Helping with any access problems
- First aiders
- Ensuring sessions start and finish promptly
- Serving refreshments and lunches
- Clearing up from 6 to 7 pm

To offer your services as a volunteer on the day, please register using the normal booking form, and indicate your choice of volunteer option (2 or 4 hour volunteer) to get the price reduction through Limmud's "Yad" scheme:

- ***Yad – 2 hours***
Commit to volunteer on the day for at least 2 hours for this discount rate
- ***Yad – 4 hours***
Commit to volunteer at least 4 hours for a free place, through the generosity of the Goldberg Charitable Trust.

Please note that if you do not complete the minimum of 4 hours, you will be asked to pay the Yad 2 hour full rate.
